Connect your hearing aid to our **HEARING LOOP** or ask for a hearing assistance device at the sound booth in the back of the sanctuary. Ear plugs are also available.

A **SIGN LANGUAGE INTERPRETER** is present the first Sunday of each month.

KIDS’ ACTIVITY BAGS are available just outside the sanctuary.

A **FAMILY ROOM** for children needing a quiet space is located in the south hallway (follow the signs across from the sanctuary). A live video stream of worship may be viewed there as well.

A **CHANGING TABLE** is available there & in the family/unisex restroom in the south hallway.
