

Wednesday Morning Bible Study Continues...

Right in the middle of the Ten Commandments is the call to keep the Sabbath, to set aside one day of the week for holy rest. In our society we've approached Sabbath in two ways. One approach sees Sabbath as a day marked by strict rules about what we're "allowed" to do and what we aren't. Another approach ignores Sabbath entirely because it is seen as an obstacle that hinders our ability to acquire and accomplish. Old Testament scholar Walter Brueggmann offers another way of understanding the biblical concept of Sabbath in his book *Sabbath as Resistance: Saying No to the Culture of Now.* Join us this fall for a Bible study on the Sabbath. Brueggemann's book will serve as our conversation partner as we dive deeply into a study of the fourth commandment and how it offers both an alternative and resistance to the culture that seeks to define us.
