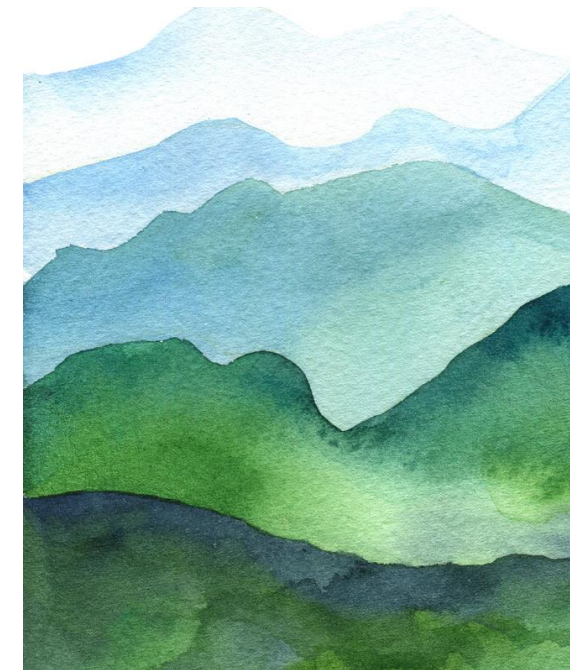

Join the Creation Care Team and find out how you can make a difference.

We read in Genesis that God created the natural world in which humans were tasked to be caretakers, so that all living things could flourish as they were designed. As individuals, we certainly carry that responsibility, but as part of the church, we are especially called and collected to be good stewards of the world around us. The father of our Reformed faith, John Calvin, may have been the first environmentalist, so we are extending his legacy by caring for the earth in this era.

Last January, many of us experienced a four-week class on Creation Care and learned that there are things people are doing and can do even more to tackle the environmental crisis. As a follow-up to that class, we are forming a Creation Care Team at Hamblen. Our first gathering will be on Sunday, February 9 directly after worship.
