Talking Back to Wrath

Genesis 49:7

Cursed be their anger, for it is fierce, and their wrath, for it is cruel! I will divide them in Jacob and scatter them in Israel.

Leviticus 19:18

¹⁸ You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against any of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the LORD.

Psalm 30:5

⁵ For [God's] anger is but for a moment; his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may linger for the night, but joy comes with the morning.

Job 19:29

be afraid of the sword, for wrath brings the punishment of the sword, so that you may know there is a judgment."

Psalm 27:9

Do not hide your face from me. Do not turn your servant away in anger, you who have been my help. Do not cast me off; do not forsake me, O God of my salvation!

Psalm 37:8

Refrain from anger and forsake wrath. Do not fret—it leads only to evil.

Psalm 78:38

Yet he, being compassionate, forgave their iniquity and did not destroy them; often he restrained his anger and did not stir up all his wrath

Psalm 103:8

The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love

Psalm 138:7

Though I walk in the midst of trouble, you preserve me against the wrath of my enemies; you stretch out your hand, and your right hand delivers me.

Proverbs 11:4

Riches do not profit in the day of wrath, but righteousness delivers from death.

Proverbs 11:23

The desire of the righteous ends only in good, the expectation of the wicked in wrath.

Proverbs 12:16

Fools show their anger at once, but the prudent ignore an insult.

Proverbs 14:29

Whoever is slow to anger has great understanding, but one who has a hasty temper exalts folly.

Proverbs 15:18

Those who are hot-tempered stir up strife, but those who are slow to anger calm contention.

Proverbs 16:32

One who is slow to anger is better than the mighty, and one whose temper is controlled than one who captures a city.

Proverbs 19:11

Those with good sense are slow to anger, and it is their glory to overlook an offense.

Proverbs 15:1

A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

Proverbs 22:24

Make no friends with those given to anger, and do not associate with hotheads,

Proverbs 29:11

A fool gives full vent to anger, but the wise quietly holds it back.

Proverbs 29:22

One given to anger stirs up strife, and the hothead causes much transgression.

Proverbs 30:33

For as pressing milk produces curds and pressing the nose produces blood, so pressing anger produces strife.

Proverbs 29:8

Scoffers set a city aflame, but the wise turn away wrath

Ecclesiastes 7:9

Do not be quick to anger, for anger lodges in the bosom of fools.

Isaiah 54:8

Micah 7:18

Zephaniah 2:3

Seek the Lord, all you humble of the land who do his commands; seek righteousness, seek humility; perhaps you may be hidden on the day of the Lord's wrath.

Matthew 5:21-24

Jesus said, ²¹"You have heard that it was said to those of ancient times, 'You shall not murder,' whoever murders shall be liable to judgment."

- ²² But I say to you that if you are angry with a brother or sister, you will be liable to judgment; and if you insult a brother or sister, you will be liable to the council; and if you say, "You fool," you will be liable to the hell of fire.

- ²⁴ leave your gift there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother or sister, and then come and offer your gift.
